BEFORE OPERATING YOUR NEW TRAILER FOR THE FIRST TIME:

Make sure you have the correct ball on your vehicle. Ball Size will be found on coupler of trailer.

Check the lug nuts- Make sure they all tightened. Check them again after the first 50 miles.

Check tire pressure- Make sure you have proper tire pressure in all tires.

Check all parts, nuts and bolts are tight.

Check that load is properly secure.

Make sure trailer is not overloaded.

Check Brakes- make sure brakes are working.

Check attachments- Make sure gates/ramps are secured.

Check jack- the jack should be in highest position.

Check that the jack handle is secured.

Safety chains must be attached to your vehicle- Do this to insure it works properly; and to avoid damage to vehicle, trailer, or self.

Failure to follow any of these can void your warranty

M.E.B. Trailer Warranty

Terms and Conditions

Your MEB trailer is warranted to the original purchaser to be free from defects in material and workmanship, for a period of 2 years on all trailers. This warranty will also cover wiring for 6 months from date of purchase. The obligations of MEB Trailer MFG under this limited warranty shall be limited to repairing or replacing any part or parts which, in the opinion of the company, shall be proved defective in material or workmanship under normal use and service during the 2 year period commencing with the date of purchase. This warranty does not cover any part or parts which have been damaged as a result of an accident, misuse, abuse, or which have been modified, altered, or repaired by anyone other than MEB Trailer MFG. This warranty shall not apply if the trailer has been subjected to loads in excess of its rated capacity, the remedies described herein are the sole remedies.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS:

This warranty shall not extend to:

1. Any trailer or component for which the warranty registration card was not returned to MEB Trailer MFG.
2. Equipment which has been modified, repaired, altered in anyway without the express written consent of MEB Trailer MFG.
3. Unreasonable use (including failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance)
4. Tires, axles, axle assemblies, suspension components, or any other equipment which is warranted separately by the respective manufacturers of said components.
5. Parts not supplied by MEB Trailer MFG.
6. Parts which require replacement in the ordinary course of use due to normal wear.

WHAT YOU MUST DO:

In order to make a claim under these warranties:

1. You must be the original purchaser of the trailer
2. You must properly notify MEB Trailers within the warranty period of any defects and provide MEB Trailer MFG with any substantiation that MEB Trailer MFG may reasonably request.
3. The trailer must have been used and maintain in accordance with good industry practice and the recommendations of MEB Trailer MFG.

LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS:

1. Warranties are non-transferable
2. The warranties are exclusive and the remedies provided therein are the sole and only remedies.
3. There are no warranties, either express or implied, including the implied warranties of merchant ability and fitness for particular purpose which extend beyond the description on the face hereof.
4. Except as maybe prohibited by law, MEB Trailer MFG, shall not be liable for incidental or consequential damages of any kind or description including but not

limited to loss of time, profit, inconvenience, loss of use , towing fees, telephone calls or cost of meals or lodging.

The limited warranty provided above, subject to the described limitations and exclusions, give you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
